

If any of these dates do not work for artists, special arrangements must be made prior to drop off by calling 631-888-3525.

If any work is left at the gallery beyond an artist's assigned pick-up date, they will be charged a warehousing fee of \$2.00 per day.

A 25% donation from sales will be accepted by Islip Arts Council.

Submitted work is juried for acceptance by the Curatorial Team of the Islip Arts Council, and all decisions are final. Submitting a work of art implies agreement on the part of the artist with all conditions set forth in this prospectus. The IAC will take reasonable care of submitted works but are not responsible for any loss or damage to said work.
